Strawberries No. 2.

Firm, ripe strawberries are put in preserving kettle and to each quart of berries (after hulled) add 1 cup of sugar; put a layer of berries, then a time or they will be brief and boil slowly \$5 minutes; skim well and fill into well-sterilized lisk, fasten and put on boller on ract; cover with boiling water 1 inch above tops of jars; cover the boller and boil 30 minutes; remove, and when cold, put in cool, dark place. Be sure they do not leak. If there is too much syrup, put in bottle for fugure use.
