RULES & REGULATIONS:-

The Oneidas and Munceys have had Rules and Regulations for the better government of their Bands, but the Chippewas have been without. As you are aware, the Chippewas have recently adopted all the Muncey Rules and Regulations. It would have been to their advantage to have adopted a more complete set of rules than those of the Munceys, but these were the only ones they had access to. It is very desirable that a standard form of rules should be drawn up and printed and a few copies be sent to all of the bands who at present have none. In the past each band, unguided by experience, has endeavoured to formulate a set of rules for itself and the result is the adoption of imperfect rules that are far from uniform and which are seldom ~~well~~ well calculated to obtain the ends desired.
