

Nine have regular pastoral care. Twelve keep up their Conference Meetings. The number baptized, thirty-three.

FOURTH DISTRICT.—This District numbers sixteen Churches. Twelve sent in reports. Elder Gunter is still pastor of the Tracy, Blissville, and Fredericton Junction Churches. He baptized one at Fredericton Junction, and two at Blissville.

The Churches at Victoria and Geary have been cared for by Elder Gravinor. Both Churches, under the labors of Brothers Gravinor and Smith, enjoyed extensive revivals. At Geary twenty-five were baptized, and at Victoria Settlement seven.

Elder Barnes has cared for the Church at Oromoeto, and has visited other Churches, helping and cheering them. At Wassis a Church was organized by Elder Harris, and eighteen were baptized.

The number of Churches having pastoral care in this District is seven. The Churches keeping up weekly and Conference Meetings not given. The number baptized, fifty-three.

FIFTH DISTRICT.—This District numbers eighteen Churches; fifteen of them reported.

Elder Merritt has had the pastoral care of the Fourth Hampstead and Second Kars Churches.

Elder Carpenter has held the pastorate of the First Kingston and Jerusalem Churches.

Elder Connor has had a busy year laboring with the following Churches, and with a good measure of success:—the First, Third, and Fourth Wickham, First Kars, and Second Greenwich Churches. In connection with the Greenwich Church he baptized twenty; in connection with the Kars Church, two.

Licentiate Robinson has labored with the Fourth Wickham, First and Second Johnston Churches.

Elder McKenzie baptized five in connection with the Third Wickham Church, and four were added by baptism to the First Johnston Church.

Elder Colpitts spent some time with the Sixth Wickham Church. God blessed his visit, and eighteen were baptized and added to it.

Licentiate Clark rendered valuable assistance to Brother Colpitts. Brother Clark has also visited other Churches in this and other Districts.

Eleven of the Churches have regular pastoral care; thirteen keep up Conferences, and three have weekly Prayer Meetings. The number baptized, forty-nine.

SIXTH DISTRICT.—Twenty-three of the twenty-five Churches of this District reported to their yearly meetings. Two of them were organized during the past year—one at Moncton, and the other at Wheaton Settlement.

Lewis Mountain, Wheaton Settlement, and Pollet River Churches were cared for by Licentiate A. Gorham until the first of last July, when God called our brother home to rest. An earnest, faithful laborer was our lamented brother. Very much have the Churches which were under his care missed him, and very sincerely have they
