

Most Successful, From a Business Point of View, in its History—Great Expan-sion During Past Five Years.

Speaking of Canada in 1902, Bradapleted, from a business point of view, the most successful year in her story. For the past five years the Dominion has been experiencing what has been called the growing time. The truth of this has found ample proof in the great expansion that has taken place in manufacturing, mer-cantile and financial circles, as well cantile and inancial circles, as wen as in the agricultural sections of the country. There was a vast increase in the wealth of the country during the past year. Various figures and statements now in course of preparation for the calendar year just end-

ration for the calendar year just ended, but which are still incomplete, unmistakably prove this fact.

The natural resources of the country attracted the attention of capitalists at home as well as in the Mother Country and in the United States. Large sums of money were invested in the development of the agricultural resources of the country, in the iron and steel industries, in the steamboat-building industry, the demands of transportation on the demands of transportation on both the ocean and inland waters having heavily stimulated the demand for vessels; in the manufacture of woolen and other lines of fabrics and in various other lines of manufacture. The difficulty with many of the Canadian mills that are now making a high-class of goods is that they are unable to meet the demand of the home markets. This is not only on account of the fact that the limit of their capacity for production has been reached, but also on account of the sarcity of skilled labor. In some cases mills have given notice to their customers that they are filled with orders that will keep them busy for the next six months, demands of transportation the next six months,

The live stock trade of the country showed much activity during the year. The shipments to the Old Country markets were heavy, and until recently, when the Government prohibited the shipment of cattle, through the Eastern States to the markets of the United Kingdom, owing to the reports of disease, the demand for export was quite brisk. The packing trade of the country, however, has been increasing, and it is likely that the difficulties of shipping Canadian cattle on the hoof to the British markets will stimulate the dressed-meat trade, especially as the British markets will stimulate the dressed-meat trade, especially as the Dominion Government has in the past year or two made arrangements which greatly facilitate the shipment of produce in cold storage to Great past year or two made arrangements which greatly facilitate the shipment of produce in cold storage to Great Britain. The pork packing industry also showed great activity, and the farmers received much money through the increased demand for hogs. Some years ago Ontario shipped 10,000,000 bushels of barley annually to the United States. The increase in the duty on that grain practically cut off that formerly large export, but since then the development of the stock feeding industry has absorbed the grain that formerly was exported, and while the prices paid now for the grain are not as large as previously, when barley sold up to 80 cents and \$1 per bushel in some seasons, that trade is scarcely missed now, this opening of new channels of trade having provided a market for a grain which, it was thought by some, many of the farmers of Eastern Ontario would have to give up growing. The demand for Canadian wool from the United States continues good. In the year just closed practically the whole of the clip of some 5,000,000 pounds was shipped to the United States in addition to large quantities left over from the previous year, in spite of the high duty imposed on this pro-

in addition to large quantities left over from the previous year, in spite of the high duty imposed on this product by the American Government.

The agricultural growth of the Dominion during the past year was very marked. The wheat production of Manitoba increased in 1902 from 45,000,000 to 60,000,000 bushels, and owing to the large increase in the number of settlers who took up land in the Northwest during the year, it is expected that in 1903 the wheat crop, with conditions as favwheat crop, with conditions as favorable as experienced last year, will be double that of the crop of 1901. The flax crop in the Northwest last and the conditions of the crop in the second to the conditions of year was double that of the year be-fore, and the production of oats and other grains was larger than in any

other grains was larger than in any previous year.

No figures in connection with the trade expansion of the Dominion that are at present available give as accurate an idea of the growth of the business and wealth of Canada during 1902 as the Government chartered banks, which have just been issued. The figures are for November, and the leading items in the statement compare with those for January as follows:

In 1726 it was in the mind of ministers to give back the rock to Spain, but so great an agitation arose against such a step that it was abandoned. There followed a siege by Spain and France, which last ed from 1727 to 1783. On Sept. 13, 1782, no fewer than 40,000 men constituted the besieging army, and in the grand attack delivered on that day 200 heavy guns, 47 ships of the line and 10 battering ships were employed, and upward of 5,000 red hot shots were fired at the fortifications. Since then the possession of Gibraltar has remained undisputed.
