## Order of the Governor in Council,

For further regulating the Inland Navigation from the United States by the Port of St. Johns.

At His Majefly's Executive Council, of and for the faid Province of Lower-Canada, held at the Caftle of Saint Lewis, in the City of Quebec, in the faid Province, on Tuefday the Twenty feeond day of August, in the thirty feventh year of. His Majefly's Reign, and in the year of our Lord, one thousand feven hundred and ninety feven.

## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

TATHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Parliament of Lower Canada made and passed in the thirty fixth year of the Reign of his present Majesly, intituled, " An Act for making temporary Provision for the regulation of Trade between this " Province and the United States of America, by Land or Inland Navigation," It is amongst other things enacted, that for and during the continuance of the faid Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of this Province for the time being, with the advice and confent of His Majefly's Executive Council, by Order or Orders to be from time to time iffued and publified, to sufficient the operation of the whole, or of any part or parts of any Ordinance or Ordinances, or of any Act or Acts of the Legillature of this Province, relative to trade and intercourfe by Land or Inland Navigation, and to give directions and make Regulations with refpect to Importations, Exportations, Duties or otherwife, for carrying on the "Trade by Land or Inland Navigation, between the People and Territories of His Majefty in this Province, and the People and Territories of His Majefly in this Province, and the People and Territories of the United States of America, any Law, Statute, Cuftom or Ulage to the contrary in any wife notwithstanding; And whereas the Powers given by the faid recited Act, are, in and by a subfequent Act of the fame Provincial Parliament, made and paffed, in the thirty feventh year of the Reign of his present Majefty, intituled, " An Act for further continuing " for a limited time, the Act made in the thirty fixth year of his prefent Majefly's " Reign," intituled, " An Act for making temporary Provision for the Regulation of " Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by Land or Inland " navigation," continued until the first day of January, one thousand feven hundred and ninety eight, and from thence to the end of the then next Seffion of the Provincial Parliament. And whereas by the Order of His Excellency the Governor in Council, made at the Caftle of Saint Lewis in the faid City of Quebec, on Thursday the seventh day of July, in the thirty fixth year of the Reign of his prefent Majefly, it is amongft other things ordered, that all Veffels, Boats, Rafts and Carriages, of what kind or nature foever, containing Goods, Wares or Merchandise, paffing by or thro' the Port of Saint
