Second s. of the late Hon. James Yeo, of Porthill, P.E.I., who came from Devonshire, Eng., 1827, and held a seat in the Provincial Assembly for a period of thirty years. B. at Porthill, 1832. M. 1855, Sarah Jane, dau. of William Glover, Esq., formerly of Devonshire, Eng. A merchant, shipbuilder and shipowner. Sat in the P.E.I. Assembly for some years before the Union with Can., and also held a seat in the Ex. Council of that Colony. First returned to Commons on P.E.I. entering the Dominion, Sept. 1873; reelected at g.e. 1874, and again at last g.e. A Liberal.—Porthill, P.E.I.
