## BILL.

An Act to remove doubts as to the extent of the powers of the Inspectors and Superintendents of the Police of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal.

HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the powers of the Inspectors Preamble. and Superintendents of the Police of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, to act in all cases as Justices of the Peace; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., declares and enacts as follows:

I. The Inspectors and Superintendents of the Police of the Cities of Powers declared Quebec and Montreal, respectively, have been and are in virtue of their Justices of the Peace of the Judicial Districts in which the above Cities are respectively situate and vested with all the powers and authorities within the limits of their respective jurisdictions of any one or two 10 Justices of the Peace, as the case may require; and all judgments rendered or to be rendered by them, respectively, have had and shall have the same force and effect as if rendered by one or two Justices of the Peace whose names are included in the Commission of the Peace for the Districts within which such Inspectors and Superintendents of Police are respectively appointed to act.
