severally praying for the passing of an Act authorizing the construction of a railway from Toronto, through or near Peterborough, Madoc, and Carlton Place to Ottawa City, and across the Ottawa River into the Province of Quebec, with power to unite, amalgamate, or make running arrangements with Railway Lines in the Provinces of Ontario

Of the Municipal Council of the Village of Trenton, in the Province of Ontario; praying for the passing of an Act to authorize the Corporation of the said village to levy and collect Harbor dues for the purpose of maintaining Booms, Piers, and otherwise

Of La Banque Nationale of Quebec; praying for the passing of an Act to authorize an increase of the capital stock of the bank, of two millions of dollars, and otherwise to

Of the Dominion Board of Trade; praying for the amendment of the laws regulating the granting of Patents, so as to provide that it shall not be necessary for a British subject to reside one year in the Dominion before his application for a Patent is granted.

Of the Montreal Board of Trade; praying for the passing of an Act to repeal the duties on Flour, Wheat, and other grain; and also on Coal and Salt.

Of the Niagara District Bank; praying for an Act to renew the Charter of the said Bank.

Of C. E. Wurtell and others, of Windsor, in the Province of Quebec; praying for the amendment of the Laws regulating the granting of Patents so as to provide that it shall not be necessary for a British subject to reside one year in the Dominion before his application for a Patent is granted.

Of Clarks Gamble, of the City of Toronto, and others, praying for an Act of Incorporation as "The Mutual Life Assurance Association of Canada."

The Honorable Mr. Simpson, from the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons, on the Printing of Parliament, presented their second and third Reports. Ordered, That they be received, and
