

(c.) construct, erect, and maintain lines of telephone along the sides of, across or under any highways, streets, public bridges, or any such places within a radius of fifteen miles from Dawson City as the Company from time to time may determine, and construct, erect and maintain so many poles, and other works and devices as the Company deems necessary for making, completing, supporting, using, working and maintaining the system of communication by telephone, with power to stretch wires thereon; and from time to time fix by its by-laws a tariff of charges in connection with and for the use of its wires and telephones, and the transmission of messages, with full power to collect, sue for and recover the charges to which it becomes entitled;

(d.) construct, equip, operate, and maintain within the aforesaid district and limits, a single or double line of tramways for the carriage of passengers and freight, with the necessary side tracks and turnouts, for the passage of cars, carriages, and other vehicles adapted thereto, together with all necessary stations, offices, houses and buildings of every description, and may levy and collect tolls from all persons and freight using, passing over or travelling upon such tramways;

(e.) contract with any person or municipality for supplying electricity and electric light, heat or power to any such person or municipality, or to any streets, passages, tramways, factories, shops, warehouses, public or private houses, buildings and places, and for such purposes may from time to time lay down, carry, fit up, connect and furnish any electric accumulator, storage battery, line, cable, wire, pipe, switch, connection, branch, burner, lamp, meter or other apparatus for or in connection with any electric main, lead or cable which for such purposes may be required, and let any such apparatus for hire for such sum as may be agreed upon;

(f.) appoint a person or persons with power at all reasonable times to enter any premises to which electricity is or has been supplied by the Company, in order to inspect the electric lines, accumulators, fittings, works and apparatus for the supply or application of electricity belonging to the Company, and therein, and for the purpose of ascertaining the quantity of electricity consumed or supplied, or where a supply of electricity is no longer required, or where the Company is authorized to take away or cut off the supply of electricity from any premises for the purposes of removing any electric lines, accumulators, transformers, motors, distribution boards, meters, fittings, lamps, works, or apparatus belonging to the Company

9. If any person neglect to pay any charge for electricity, or any other sum due from him to the Company, either in respect of the supply of electricity to such person, or in respect of the rent reserved by the Company for the use of electric lines, meters, accumulators, transformers, motors, distribution boards, lamps, telephones, fittings, works, or apparatus lent or supplied for hire to such person, the Company may cut or disconnect any electric line or other work through which electricity may be supplied, and remove such articles and works above mentioned as were lent for hire to such person.
