BILL.

An Act to render the judgments of the late Provincial Court for the Inferior District of Saint Francis executory, and for the Removal of the Records of the said Court into the Circuit Court at Sherbrooke.

THEREAS by the Act passed in the Session held Preamble. in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to provide for the more easy and ex-4 & 5 Vict. c. "peditious administration of Justice in Civil Cases, and 20. 5 "matters involving small pecuniary value, in that part of "this Province heretofore Lower Canada," the late Provincial Court for the Inferior District of Saint Francis was abolished; and whereas by the said recited Act no provision was made for the removal of the records of the 10 said late Provincial Court into the District Court thereby established or to render the judgments theretofore rendered in the said late Provincial Court executory in the said District Court; and whereas no provision was made by the Act passed in the seventh year of Her Majesty's 15 Reign, and intituled "An Act to repeal certain Acts and 7 Vict. c. 16. " Ordinances therein mentioned, and to make better provision "for the administration of Justice in Lower Canada," for the removal of the records of the said late Provincial Court into the Court of Queen's Bench at the Inferior 20 Terms thereof for the said District of Saint Francis by the said last cited Act established, or for rendering executory the judgments of the said late Provincial Court; in consequence whereof the said judgments of the said late Provincial Court have remained unexecuted or it 25 hath been necessary to have them declared executory by other judgments obtained at great cost; for remedy

That the Registers, Muniments, Records, Official Acts, Registers, &c. and Papers and other proceedings of the said late Pro-cial Court to 30 vincial Court shall immediately after the passing of this be transmitted into the Cir-Act be transmitted into and make part of the Records, cuit Court; Muniments and other judicial proceedings of "The Circuit judgments of P. Court made Court" for the Sherbrooke Circuit at the Town of Sher-executory. brooke in the District of Saint Francis, and that the judg-35 ments of the said late Provincial Court shall and may be executed as if they were judgments of the said Circuit Court, and the Clerk of the said Circuit Court for the said Sherbrooke Circuit shall accordingly issue execution under the said judgments, and ulterior proceedings shall 40 be had thereupon, as if the said judgments were judgments
