(10) XIV.—And be it further enacted, that the following Rates of Fees shall be paid by Pupils attending the several Schools to be established under the provisions of this Act, to be appropriated towards the Salaries of the Masters of such Schools;—that is to say,—the Sum of 5s. annually for every Pupil learning Reading and Writing only, and the Sum of 7s. 6d. annually for each Pupil instructed in Reading, Writing, and Arithmetic: Provided that nothing therein contained shall be construed to prevent the Children of such persons who are unable, from poverty, to pay such Fees as aforesaid, from being instructed gratuitously in the said Schools.

(20) XV.—And be it further enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for the Protestant Boards in the undermentioned Districts, each year, respectively, out of the Monies hereinbefore appropriated to such Boards, to contribute to the support of Schools of the Newfoundland School Society, within the said several Districts, to the amounts following, respectively,—that is to say,—The Board for the District of St. John's, to an amount not exceeding £75; The Board for the District of Brigus, an amount not exceeding £25; The Board for the District of Harbour Grace, an amount not exceeding £100; The Board for the District of Carbonear, an amount not exceeding £25; The Board for the District of Trinity Bay, South, an amount not exceeding £30; The Board for the District of Trinity Bay, North, an amount not exceeding £60; The Board for the District of Bonavista, South, an amount not exceeding £25; The Board for the District of Bonavista, North, an amount not exceeding £25; The Board for the District of Fogo, an amount not exceeding £25; The Board for the District of Twillingate, an amount not exceeding £60; The Board for the District of Fortune Bay, an amount not exceeding £50; Provided always, that the said Society has, at the time such Sums may be granted, good Schools, or Branch Schools, in operation within such Districts respectively.

(30) XVI.—And be it further enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for the Protestant Boards in the Districts of St. John's, Brigus, Harbour Grace, Carbonear, Trinity Bay North, Trinity Bay South, and Burin, respectively, out of the Sums hereinbefore appropriated to them in each year, to contribute to the support of the Wesleyan Methodist Schools, in their several Districts, the Sums following,—that is to say,—The Board for St. John's, £25; The Board for Brigus, £25; The Board for Carbonear, £50; The Board for Trinity Bay, North, £25; The Board for Trinity Bay, South, £25; The Board for Burin, £25; And the Board for Harbour Grace, £25: Provided always, that there be under the management of the Wesleyan Methodists, at the time such sums may be granted, good Schools or Branch Schools, in operation within such Districts respectively.

(40) XVII.—And be it further enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for the Catholic Board for the District of St. John's, to appropriate the Sum of £150 per annum to the support of the Orphan Asylum School, and the Sum of £150 per annum to the support of the Nunnery School, in the said District, out of the amount hereinbefore appropriated to such District; and for the Catholic Board for the District of Harbour Grace to appropriate the Sum of £50 per annum to the support of the St. Patrick's Free School, in the said District, out of the amount hereinbefore appropriated to such District.
