An Act to amend Chapter 71 of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the Medical Profession and the sale of Drugs.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend chapter seventy-one of the Con- preamble. solidated Statutes of Lower Canada intimized at the second s solidated Statutes of Lower Canada, intituled : "An Act respecting the Medical Profession and the sale of Drugs," and to make better provision for the granting of licenses for the sale and distribution of Medi-

5 cine by retail in Lower Canada: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Section sixteen of chapter seventy-one of the Consolidated Statutes New section for Lower Canada, is hereby repealed and the following shall be sub-substituted for sect. 16. 10 stituted therefor and read in lieu thereof :-

"16. Except such persons as may lawfully practice Physic in Lower What persons Canada, no person whatsoever shall on any pretence, sell or distribute only shall sell medicine by retail in Lower Canada, who shall not have obtained a Lower Canada license from the Provincial Medical Board, which license the said Board da.

15 are hereby authorized to grant to any person applying for the same who shall have passed such examination in pharmacy as the Board may deem satisfactory, and such license shall be enregistered in the Books of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada."

And whereas persons desirous of obtaining licenses to sell or dis-Licenses 20 tribute medicine by retail in Lower Canada, have from time to time granted by the presented themselves before the Provincial Medical Board, and on pass-medical Board ing satisfactory examinations have obtained such licenses, and doubts declared valid have arisen as to the validity of such licenses, it is enacted, that all licenses to sell and distribute medicines by retail in Lower Canada which

25 may have been heretofore granted by the Provincial Medical Board, shall be held to be valid and sufficient and to confer and to have conferred on the grantees thereof all the rights and powers conferred by any license that might have been granted under the sixteenth section of the Act above cited.
