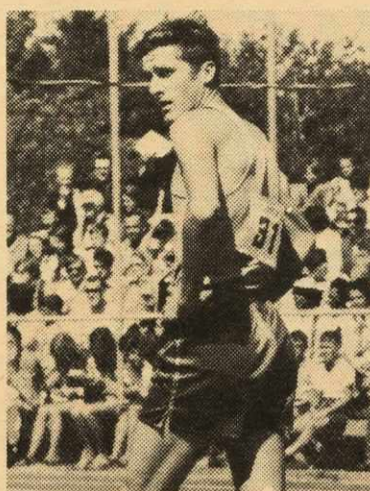

Tigers Open Sept. 19th

The Dalhousie Varsity Football Tigers are nearing the end of a two week training camp which began on September 1. The team has been practicing twice a day preparing for the upcoming Blue-nose Conference football season.

Head Coach Dick Loiselle has about twenty five veterans and an equal number of promising rookies in camp and the combination is expected to make the Tigers leading contenders for the

Conference title.

The squad has just a few days left to prepare for their only exhibition game of the season. On Friday, September 19 at 8:00 P.M., the Tigers are host to the University of Manitoba Bisons at Studly Field. The Bisons finished in a first place tie with the traditionally powerful University of Alberta Golden Bears last season. They then defeated Alberta in a playoff game and later represented the Western Intercollegiate Athletic Union in National Playoffs but were defeated by Vanier Cup winners, Queens University.

The Tigers will play two of their most important conference games in the two succeeding weeks, meeting St. Mary's in their new stadium on September 27 and playing the St. Francis Xavier X-Men on October 4.

After a two week layoff the

Bengals will play Mount Allison at Studley Field on Oct. 18 and the following Saturday will travel to Fredericton for an afternoon contest with the University of New Brunswick.

University of Prince Edward Island will take on the Bengals at Dalhousie on November 1 and the Tigers will wind up the Conference schedule with a trip to Acadia on the following weekend.
