But suffer us to remind you that a large tract was sold by the Wyandot and Delaware Nations to the state of Pennsylvania. this tract lies East of a line drawn from the mouth of Beaver Creek, at the Ohio due North to Lake Erie. This line is the western boundary of Pennsylvania as claimed by the charter given by the King of England to your ancient friend William Penn. of this sale made by the Wyandot
