 statement prepared by you of the

 chargeable at six per cent on all
 arrears from the date the same
 were due up to the date of payment
 thereof. After collecting the rents due
 on these lands you should deposit
 the amount in the nearest branch
 of the Bank of Montreal to the
 credit of the Receiver General on
 account of Indian funds and
 forward
