Madam,

I am returning herewith Certificate as to the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 24, Thompson, for amendment, and beg to refer you to letter of the 16th Ultimo, stating that an error was made by the Agent in the description of land for which Patent was applied in the name of Joseph Scott. It will be observed that request is made in that letter to have the Certificate amended, and valuation made in accordance with the correct description, being the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$ , instead of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24. But a new Certificate has evidently been forwarded, which leaves out the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 23 Thompson. You will, therefore, be good enough to have Mr. S.M. Fraser include <sup>in</sup> the Certificate enclosed, report on the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 23, or if this cannot be conveniently done, he might forward a new Certificate for this land, and return the one herewith enclosed.
