That a division of the Capital from which their Interest money is derived cannot be granted; but that, in order to aid them in their agricultural pursuits, a yoke of well trained sound working oxen, not to exceed four years old, may be purchased for the Indians, providing that they have the means of stabling, feeding and in all respects properly caring for them during the winter; and the twelve hoes may also be procured for them. I have to request that you will inform the Department of the result of your enquiries respecting the oxen and say for what price a suitable yoke can be purchased.
