Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo with enclosure from the Rev. Father Beaudette in reference to the school building at Whiting.

In reply I beg to say that the Department only wishes the use of the sum in this building and it is not disposed to pay a sum of \$20,000 a month, or, outside of the use of the sum, the cost of the building would be of no advantage. An officer of the Department wishes to visit Whiting in the near future and if no Father Beaudette will be requested to meet him there in order that there may be an interview and some satisfactory arrangement made. In the meantime it is proposed that the school will allow the school to be conducted in one of the rooms pending some final arrangement.
