I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th Instant, regarding poles placed on occupied and unoccupied lands on Stony Indian Reserve, under Permit held by the Calgary Power Company, and in connection therewith would refer you to your letter of the 25th Ultimo, in which you state that \$400.00 was paid and divided among the Indians, while in letter first referred to you report \$457.50 as the total payment. I have to request you to be good enough to forward the sum of \$57.50 to the Department, in order that the same may be entered and so the account brought up to date.
