Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 1st instant, I beg to say that, if Dr. Chisholm joins a medical corps for service at the front, his work on behalf of Indians may be handed over to Dr. W. R. Stone, of Vanderhoof. You should report definitely in the matter when you have further information, and if Dr. Chisholm goes to the war, and his work is performed by Dr. Stone, you should request for payment of salary to the latter at the same rate as has been allowed Dr. Chisholm, namely \$600.00 a year.
