Reserve No.6 as comprised under Prov.Mining Leases Nos.

416.417.418.419 and 456,it would appear that an original
plan prepared by H.Smith B.C.L.S.shows old leases Nos.

354.355.356 which are now represented by leases Nos.

416.417 and 418,and it is therefore suggested that,using
such plan as a basis, Mr. Gates have an amended plan
made on tracing lines by a qualified surveyor, showing
the boundaries of the present leases 416,417,418,419 and

456.

In this way there will be no confusion of lease boundaries and the Department will then be in a position to grant lease of surface rights.
