How was the accused dressed ?

As he is now, in a pair of coveralls.

Do you remember the words you used when you ordered him to put on the uniform? Just as I gave them, sir.

Will you state what your actual words were ?

I gave him the uniform and ordered him "put it on" and he did not do so.

You were on duty at the time ?

Yes, sir.

Did the accused give any reason for not putting it on ? No. sir, he just said he would not put it on.

THE DEFENDING OFFICER DECLINES TO CROSS EXAMINE THIS WITNESS.

QUESTIONED BY THE COURT:

Did the accused ever put the uniform on ? Not to my knowledge, sir. He did not put it on in my presence when I ordered him to do so.

Will you take a look at the accused now ? How is he dressed ? The same as the day I ordered him to put on the uniform, sir.

THE WITNESS WITHDRAWS.

## Third witness for Prosecution:

G.32666 Sgt. E.M KILLAM, No. XI District Depot, CA. being duly sworn is examined by the Prosecutor:

- What are your duties at the depot ? I am in charge of No. XI District Depot detention barracks and am on duty practically every day and since September 15th, Leduc.....
- Correction! Is that the 15th. ? It was the 15th, at 1230 hours when he was admitted and he was not wearing a uniform.
- How has he been dressed all that time ? Dressed in coveralls the entire period.

CROSS EXAMINED BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER:

- Leduc has a uniform to wear ? There was no uniform there and there has not been since he has been in on September 15th.
- He did not have one in his possession ? No. sir, nat during the time he was in there.

THE PROSECUTOR DECLINES TO REEXAMINE THIS WITNESS.

THE WITNESS WITHDRAWS.

THE PROSECUTOR HAS NO FURTHER WITNESS TO CALL.
