

Q How was the accused dressed ?

A As he is now, in a pair of coveralls.

Q Do you remember the words you used when you ordered him to put on the uniform ?
A Just as I gave them, sir.

Q Will you state what your actual words were ?

A I gave him the uniform and ordered him "put it on" and he did not do so.

Q You were on duty at the time ?

A Yes, sir.

Q Did the accused give any reason for not putting it on ?

A No, sir, he just said he would not put it on.

THE DEFENDING OFFICER DECLINES TO CROSS EXAMINE THIS WITNESS.

QUESTIONED BY THE COURT:

Q Did the accused ever put the uniform on ?

A Not to my knowledge, sir. He did not put it on in my presence when I ordered him to do so.

Q Will you take a look at the accused now ? How is he dressed ?

A The same as the day I ordered him to put on the uniform, sir.

THE WITNESS WITHDRAWS.

Third witness
for Prosecution: G. 32666 Sgt. E.M. KILLAM, No. XI District Depot, CA.
being duly sworn is examined by the Prosecutor:

Q What are your duties at the depot ?

A I am in charge of No. XI District Depot detention barracks and am on duty practically every day and since September 15th. Leduc.....

Q Correction! Is that the 15th. ?

A It was the 15th. at 1230 hours when he was admitted and he was not wearing a uniform.

Q How has he been dressed all that time ?

A Dressed in coveralls the entire period.

CROSS EXAMINED BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER:

Q Leduc has a uniform to wear ?

A There was no uniform there and there has not been since he has been in on September 15th.

Q He did not have one in his possession ?

A No, sir, not during the time he was in there.

THE PROSECUTOR DECLINES TO REEXAMINE THIS WITNESS.

THE WITNESS WITHDRAWS.
