INTERNAL ORGANS OF THE HORSE.

This cut shows the position of each organ in the body.

- 1. Pharynx, or throat.
- 2. Œsopliagus, or the tube which carries the food to the stomach.
- 3. Right lung.
- 4. Spleen.
- 5. Stomach.
- 6. Liver.
- 7. Kidney.
- S. Ureter. This is the tube whichcarries the water or urine from the kidneys to the bladder. There is one tube to each kidney.
- 9. Rectum, or back bowel.
- 10. Bladder.
- 11. Urethra.
- 12. Small bowels.
- 13. Large bowels.
- 14. Diaphragm, or curtain which separates the stomach and bowels from the lungs and heart.
- 15. Heart.
- Common Aorta, which is the largest artery in the body.
- 17. Traches, or wind pipe.
- 18. Mouth.
