

R. Burns, D. D., then a minister of Knox's church Toronto, the first minister, Rev. J. McLachlan, was ordained the 20th day of August, 1851, and was succeeded by the present minister, Rev. J. Cameron on the 5th day of Nov, 1862.

The village is distant from Toronto 35 miles, from Guelph 13, and from Milton the County Town 12 miles. Population 700.
