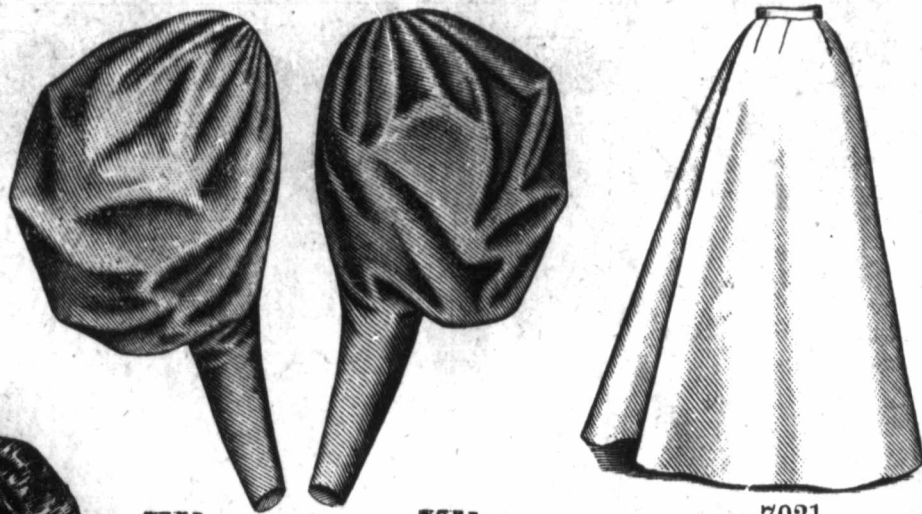




FIGURE No. 268 K.—LADIES' PLAIN ROUND BASQUE.
 FIGURE No. 268 K.—This represents Ladies' basque No. 7010 (copyright), also pictured on page 5 of this issue. The pattern is in 15 sizes for ladies from 28 to 48 inches, bust measure, and costs 25 cents. For a lady of medium size, the basque needs $3\frac{3}{4}$ yards of goods 22 inches wide, or $2\frac{5}{8}$ yards 30 inches wide, or $1\frac{1}{2}$ yard 44 inches wide, or $1\frac{1}{4}$ yard 50 inches wide.

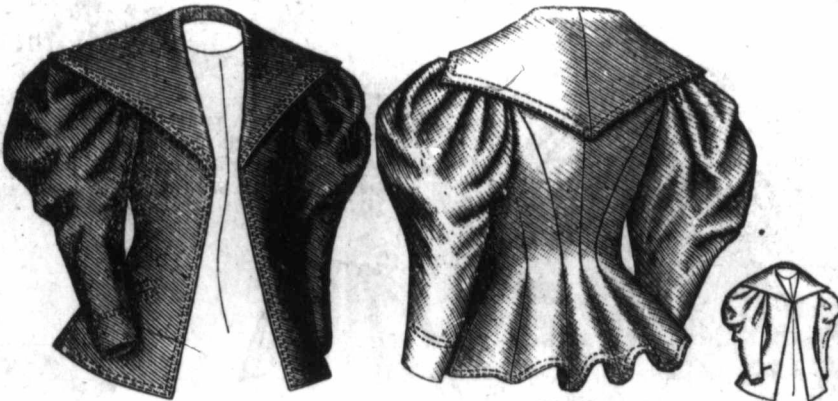

 LADIES' ONE-SEAM LARGE LEG-O'-MUTTON DRESS SLEEVE, WITH A PUFF OR BALLOON EFFECT IN THE UPPER PART AND A FITTED LINING. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7055.—This sleeve is also shown at figure No. 259 K on page 5 of this issue. The pattern is in 7 sizes for ladies from 9 to 15 inches, arm measure, measuring the arm about an inch below the bottom of the arm's-eye. For a lady whose arm measures 11 inches as described, a pair of sleeves will need $3\frac{1}{8}$ yards of goods 22 inches wide. Price of pattern, 10 cents.

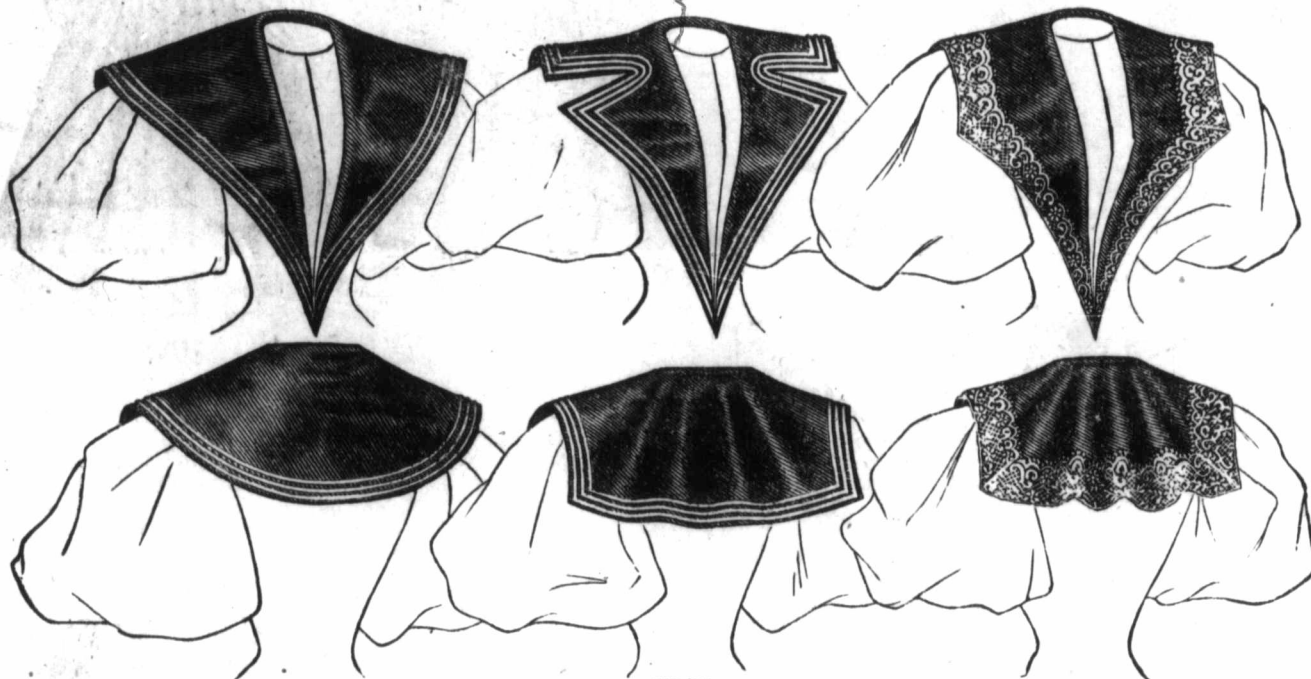

 GIRLS' JACKET OR BLAZER. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7038.—This pattern is in 7 sizes for girls from 3 to 9 years of age. To make the garment for a girl of 8 years, needs $4\frac{1}{4}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards 44 inches wide, or $1\frac{3}{4}$ yard 54 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.

LADIES' LARGE COLLARS, EXTENDING IN REVERS TO THE WAIST. (COPYRIGHT.)
 No. 7037.—Either of these collars impart a stylish air to basques that are plainly completed. The pattern is in 3 sizes, small, medium and large. In the medium size, the outside section of either collar calls for $\frac{3}{8}$ yard of goods 27 or more inches wide. Price of pattern, 10 cents.

LADIES' THREE-PIECE SKIRT. (TO BE GATHERED OR DART-FITTED.) (COPYRIGHT.)
 No. 7021.—This skirt consists of a circular front and a fancy facing that may be omitted, and two fluted or *godet* back-gores. The pattern is in 9 sizes for ladies from 20 to 36 inches, waist measure. For a lady of medium size, it needs $5\frac{3}{4}$ yards of goods 22 inches wide, or $5\frac{1}{2}$ yards 30 inches wide, with $1\frac{3}{8}$ yard of moiré 20 inches wide for facing. Price of pattern, 30 cents.



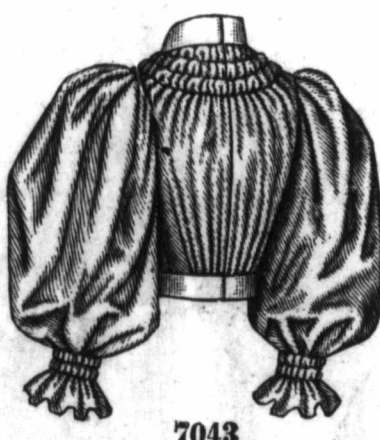

MISSES' SHIRRED WAIST. (WITH FITTED LINING). (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7043.—Wool crépon in a delicate pink shade is the material represented in this waist, which is an excellent mode for slim girls, as it tends to give an appearance of fullness to the figure. Gimp or ribbon may be appropriately used for trimming. The pattern is in 9 sizes for misses from 8 to 16 years of age. To make the waist for a miss of 12 years, will require $4\frac{3}{4}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or $3\frac{3}{8}$ yards 30 inches wide, or $2\frac{1}{4}$ yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.

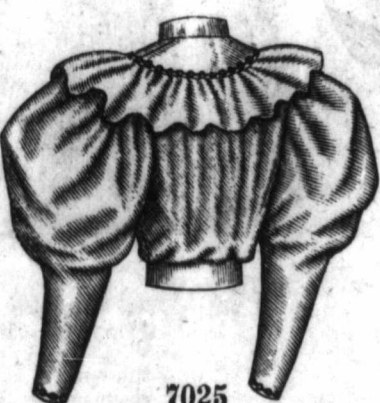

MISSES' ROUND-YOKE BLOUSE-WAIST, WITH FITTED LINING (THAT MAY BE OMITTED). (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7025.—Cotton cheviot, percale, chambray, lawn or wash silks showing stripes or figures in pale tones of blue, heliotrope, etc., are very pretty for making up waists of this kind. The pattern is in 7 sizes for misses from 10 to 16 years old. For a miss of 12 years, the waist needs 5 yards of goods 22 inches wide, or 4 yards 30 inches wide, or $3\frac{1}{8}$ yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.

CHILD'S JACKET. (KNOWN AS THE REEFER JACKET.) (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7047.—This pattern is in 7 sizes for children from 2 to 8 years of age. To make the jacket for a child of 5 years, needs $2\frac{3}{4}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or $1\frac{3}{8}$ yard 44 inches wide, or $1\frac{1}{4}$ yard 54 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.

MISSES' JACKET, WITH ETON FRONT. (COPYRIGHT.)
 No. 7007.—This jacket possesses some of the jaunty characteristics of the Eton modes and is shown made of fine serge. The pattern is in 7 sizes for misses from 10 to 16 years of age. For a miss of 12 years, it requires $4\frac{1}{2}$ yards of material 22 inches wide, or $2\frac{3}{8}$ yards 44 inches wide, or $1\frac{3}{4}$ yard 54 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.
