

Session the sum of fifteen shillings per diem, allowing Twenty Miles for each day's travel, to be certified by the Speaker; the same to be in lieu of any sum which the Speaker or Members of this House may be entitled to, by any Act to be passed this Session.

Upon which Resolution of Appropriation, the Resolution recommended by the Committee was read by the Clerk as follows:—

RESOLVED, That the further consideration of this Resolution be postponed until the next Session of the General Assembly.

And the question of concurrence being put upon this Resolution, it was agreed to by this House.

ORDERED, That the Master in Chancery do go down to the Assembly and communicate to that House the foregoing proceedings upon the Resolutions of Appropriations dated the 17th of June.

Message from the Assembly, by Mr. Taylor, that they have agreed to the amendments made to the Bill to amend an Act to repeal all the Laws now in force relating to Saint Andrew's Church in the City of Saint John, and for incorporating certain persons Pewholders of the said Church and of the several Churches erected or to be erected in the Province in connexion with the Church of Scotland.

Read a third time as amended, and passed the Bill to incorporate *The Saint John Mechanics' Whale Fishing Company*.

ORDERED, That the Master in Chancery do go down to the Assembly, and acquaint that House, that the Legislative Council have agreed to this Bill with amendments, to which they desire the concurrence of the Assembly.

Read a second time, the Bill to provide for the expenses of the Speaker and Members of the House of Assembly attending in General Assembly.

On motion—RESOLVED, That the further consideration of the said Bill be postponed until the next Session of the General Assembly.

The Honorable the Attorney General presented the following Petitions:—

A Petition from the Corporation of the City of Saint John, praying for the passage of an Act to prevent certain trespasses in the City of Saint John; and

A Petition from the Corporation of the City of Saint John, praying for additional powers to be given them as conservators of the Harbour of Saint John.

ORDERED, That the said Petitions be received and lie on the Table.
