ERRATUM.

Page 132, last line; after the word "Her," insert the following words:—

"Majesty's Mails, and such Steamer or other Vessel, while lying at the said Wharfs, shall and may use any part of the said Wharfs while landing the said Mails, or while unloading or loading any part of the cargo or ballast of such Steamer or Vessel, or for any other purpose which may be required and deemed necessary by the said Lieutenant Governor and Council,

or the master, owner, or person in charge of such Steamer or Vessel, any thing in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding."

And the said clause being thrice read was agreed to by the House, and ordered to form part of the Bill, by way of rider.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass.

Ordered, That the Hon. Mr. Longworth do carry the said Bill to the Council and desire their concurrence.
