

PROCLAMATION.

J. G. LEMARCHANT, (L.S.) By His Excellency Sir JOHN GASPARD LEMARCHANT, Knight and Knight Commander of the Orders of St. Ferdinand and Charles the Third of Spain, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until THURS-DAY the *Twenty-seventh* day of *September* next: And Whereas I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until THURSDAY the *Fifteenth* day of *November* next ensuing :

I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further PROROGUE the said GENERAL ASSEM-BLY until THURSDAY the *Fifteenth* day of *November* next; of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.
