SCHULTZ BROS. TO BUILD NEW PUBLIC WAITING ROOM

City Council Gave Them the Contract Last Night at Cost of \$5468 - Returning Officers Appointed For Municipal Elections.

Outside of the local option by-law the most important matter before the Council last night and one which took the most time, was the Grand Valley Railway report.

A detailed summary of this report appears elsewhere in this issue.

FINANCE COMMITTEE Besides the local option clause the Finance Committee recommended that the letter from the recruiting league be filed and a cheque be sent to it for \$100.

B. AND G. COMMITTEE Schultz Bros. were the successful tenderers for the new waiting room and lavatory to be built on the market square at a price of \$5468.

By-law to provide for the establishment and election of a municipal Railway Commission sponsored by Aldermen Bragg and Suddaby was put through its second and third readings.

By-law to authorize the agreement to repair the sluiceway dam was passed and adopted.

Mr. A. K. Bunnell wrote that the \$100,000 worth of city debentures had been hypothecated to the Brantford Trust Co.

The Parks board has sent to the city \$150, their contribution towards purchasing the property on West and Clarence streets from Mrs. Phoebe Williams.
