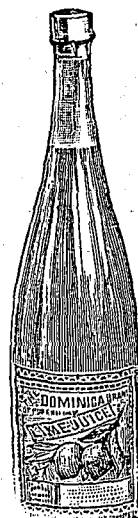

The stock was an old one and a dear purchase at 90c. in the dollar; it is actually said that he could have put in new goods cheaper, as market prices had been declining. He now owns to a deficit of \$2,500, which shows that his debts have accumulated at the rate of about \$150 per month, as he has been in business only eighteen to twenty months. It is learned that he ran three or four grocery and several dry goods accounts in Montreal at the same time, and in the words of a creditor who learned this too late to drop him, "he was getting altogether too much credit." Scotland is said to be contemplating an offer of 40c.

THE assignee of the estate of the St. Henri Carriage Leather Company has paid the first dividend of 60c on the dollar, and it is expected that nearly 100c will be realized.
