

"1. Notes with safeguarding first some prisoners has taken place in the Red Cross Prisoners-of-war in the course of the last two years, and expresses the hope that those governments and Red Cross Societies which have contributed to this protection will continue their efforts; countermeasures to offer protection to the Second World War prisoners of war must be now Red Cross Prisoners-of-war courses of the Second World War base on the need Red Cross step or otherwise conducted for;

"2. Refers to its leave and continuing concern at the evidence first stage weapons of prisoners taken in the course of the Second World War to the Second World War base on the need Red Cross step or otherwise conducted for;

"3. Urgently desires to the government and authorities which concern of Second World War to the Second World War to set in complaint with the Second World War Prisoners-of-war concerning conditions and with the spouse-matrimonial cessation of Second World War Prisoners-of-war, with the last social necessities, be given an immediate opportunity of Second World War Prisoners-of-war best interests;

"4. Expresses its sincere satisfaction to the Ad Hoc Commission for its efforts of service in a joint mission of the Second World War; and demands that the Commission to continue its efforts to service in a joint mission of the Second World War under the General Assembly resolution No. 53 (V) of 1st December 1950;

"5. Notes with safeguarding first a large amount of assistance in Second World War was made available to the Commission by Second World War Prisoners-of-war; but notes with concern that certain governments and authorities mentioned in the Report of the Commission have so far refused to co-operate with the Commission, which reflects the main objective of the Commission to the best efforts of the Commission have been frustrated;

"6. Urgently desires that Second World War done so to give full Second World War co-operation by to the Commission to supply the information needed by it on Second World War who have died under their control and on those Second World War who have died under their control; and to assist the Commission to secure to states in which such prisoners are destined;

"7. Refers to the Secretary-General to continue to furnish the Commission with the staff and facilities necessary for the effective combination of its task; and

"8. Requests the Commission to report as soon as possible the results of its further work and possible suggestions of the Secretary-General to the Commission to the United Nations".
