(f) The Project Manager shall be the focal point for all liaison with the Senegalese Co-operating Agency and all other authorities and persons in Senegal.

Article 2—Identification of Personnel

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (d) of this Article, all personnel assigned to the Experiment by the Organization or by any participating Member State who are required to reside temporarily in Senegal or who may be required to enter Senegal occasionally shall carry a completed identity card in the form set forth in the appendix hereto.
- (b) The designated Co-operating Agencies of each participating Member State shall notify the Senegalese Co-operating Agency of the names of the personnel which that state has assigned to the Experiment in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Article, together with any other data regarding such individuals which may be required for the completion of their identity cards.
- (c) The Senegalese Co-operating Agency shall arrange for the preparation and issue, to each of the individuals designated in accordance with paragraph (b) of this Article, of a completed identity card.
- (d) The provisions of paragraph (a) of this Article shall not apply to seamen of vessels calling at Senegalese ports, or to crews of aircraft landing temporarily at Senegalese airports, in connexion with the Experiment, provided that any such seaman or aircrew member is in possession of the customary seaman's or aircrew member's identification papers.

Article 3—Co-operation of Naval Vessels of other Participating Member States

The customary clearance procedure through diplomatic channels shall be followed by any other participating Member State which desires authorization for entry into Senegalese inland or territorial waters for one or more of its naval vessels co-operating in the Experiment.

Article 4—Hospital and Medical Services

The Senegalese authorities:

- (a) shall make hospital space and services available as needed, on a reimbursable basis, and shall arrange for the hospitals involved to assist in preparing the formal documentation normally required in the case of an individual covered by a health insurance plan;
- (b) shall provide a list of the names, addresses and telephone numbers of recommended doctors and dentists in private practice.

Article 5—Specific Undertakings on the Part of the Senegalese Co-operating Agency

The Senegalese Co-operating Agency:

(a) on terms to be agreed, in a separate document, between that Agency and the Co-operating Agencies of the interested other participating Member States, shall construct and maintain, or arrange for the construction and maintenance of, a GATE Operations Building at Dakar Airport which building shall be air-conditioned, shall be adequately equipped with electric light and power, water supply, sewerage and telephone service and sufficiently large to meet the space requirements of all participating states (855 square metres).
