

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE
 GOVERNMENT OF NORWAY FOR AIR SERVICES BETWEEN THE
 TWO COUNTRIES
 ACCORD ENTRE LE CANADA ET LA NORVEGE RELATIF A
 CES AERIES ENTRE LES DEUX PAYS
 PREAMBLE

The Government of Canada and the Government of Norway, hereinafter
 described as the "Contracting Parties," desiring to establish direct air communi-
 cations between Canada and Norway, agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Each contracting party grants to the other contracting party the rights
 specified in the Annex to this Agreement for the purpose of the establishment of
 the air services therein described (hereinafter referred to as the "air services").
 The air services may be inaugurated immediately or at a later date at the
 option of the contracting party to whom the rights are granted.

ARTICLE 2

In order to prevent discriminatory practices and to ensure equality of treat-
 ment, the contracting parties agree that:

(1) Each of them may impose or permit to be imposed on airlines of the
 other State, just and reasonable charges for the use of public airports and other
 facilities in its territory provided that these charges shall not be higher than
 would be paid for the use of such airports and facilities by its national airlines
 engaged in similar international services.
