The Department of External Affairs announced that Mr. Delfin H. Pupo y Proenza presented today to His Excellency the Governor General at Government House his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Cuba to Canada.

Mr. L.B. Pearson, Secretary of State for External Affairs, was present. Mr. H.F. Feaver, Head of the Protocol Division, presented Mr. Pupo y Proenza to His Excellency the Governor General. The Ambassador was accompanied by Dr. Américo Cruz Fernandez, Counsellor at his Embassy.

Mr. Pupo y Proenza was born in Banes, Oriente Province, Cuba. He studied at Columbia University and graduated in administrative and commercial law. He has been a director of the Cuban Chamber of Commerce in the United States since 1945, and was appointed treasurer in 1949. Mr. Pupo was a member of the Cuban Mission which visited the Trade Fair in Toronto in 1949.
