RULING BY MR. DEPUTY SPEAKER

MR. DEPUTY SPEAKER: I assume that the honourable Member is moving a subamendment to the amendment moved by the honourable Member for Winnipeg North (Mr. Orlikow). I therefore suggest that by moving his subamendment the honourable Member is anticipating the Committee Stage of the bill and that it would be more appropriate to move this subamendment at that stage of our proceedings. Furthermore, citation 394(1) of Beauchesne's Fourth Edition is relevant to this point.

Debate was resumed on the motion of Mr. Pelletier, seconded by Mr. Mackasey, That Bill C-171, An Act to amend the Company of Young Canadians Act be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Broadcasting, Films and Assistance to the Arts.

And on the proposed amendment of Mr. Orlikow, seconded by Mr. Rose, in amendment thereto,—That Bill C-171 be not now read a second time, but that it be resolved that in the opinion of this House the Government should give consideration to the introduction of a measure to provide for an interim financial administrator having general supervision of the expenditures of the Company of Young Canadians without the power to interfere with the program of the Company as determined by the Council and the Executive Director.
