NATO—OFFER BY U.S. OF MISSILE-CARRYING
SUBMARINES

The only report we have is the press report to the effect that such matters as disarmament were given support and that the West Berlin question was discussed. As well, there was a reference to the subject matter of the point raised by the hon. gentleman.
