64. When the Senate is put into Committee of the Whole every senator shall sit in the place assigned to that senator. A senator who desires to speak shall rise and address the Chair.

Rules in
Commit-
tee of the

65. (1) The Rules of the Senate shall apply in Committee of the Whole with the following exceptions:

- (a) the rules limiting the number of times of speaking shall not apply;
- (b) a motion for the previous question or for an adjournment shall not be received;
- (c) arguments against the principle of the bill shall not be admitted.

(2) In Committee of the Whole a senator may at any time move "that the chairman leave the Chair" or "that the chairman report progress and ask leave to sit again". Either motion shall be decided forthwith without debate and if resolved in the negative the motion shall not be reintroduced unless some intermediate proceeding has taken place. If the motion "that the chairman leave the Chair" is resolved in the affirmative, the chairman shall at once leave the Chair, shall make no report to the Senate, and the bill or other matter referred to the committee shall not reappear on the Order Paper.

(3) The proceedings of a Committee of the Whole shall be entered in the *Journals of the Senate*.
