

3. Feeding tests are necessary for the completion of some of the experiments now under way.

The most immediate need is for the development of the chemical aspect of our research problems.

- B. More help is needed to adequately carry on the present program and to make it possible to undertake other projects. A number of important agronomic problems cannot be satisfactorily undertaken at present, e.g., the pasture work, fertilizer investigations, weed eradication, etc.
- C. The nature of agronomic work necessitates the immediate attention of the staff throughout the whole calendar year. To maintain a high standard it is necessary that the members of the staff keep in touch with other workers, which is almost impossible under the short holiday period at present existing. Provision should therefore be made so that men can get away for at least one term occasionally to study and work with the best authorities in their field.

1. Need and Opportunity.
