o ordinary negotiable paper, payable on demand, is that it is not due without demand until after the lapse of a reasonable time within which to make demand, and what the length of hat reasonable time is may vary according to the circumstances of particular cases, and must be governed very largely by the intentions of the parties as manifested in the character of the paper itself and the purposes for which it is known to have been created and put in circulation. . . In reference to the bonds involved in this litigation, we have no nesitation in saying that at the time the title of the purchasers was acquired no unreasonable length of time clapsed after the maturity of the call. On the contrary, we think any holder had a right, without prejudice except as to loss of interest, to wait without demand for the whole period at the expiration of which the bond was unconditionally payable. . . . We are, therefore, of opinion that the title of Morgan & Co and Von Heffman & Co, respectively, to the bonds claimed by them ought to have pretailed against that set up by the Manhattan Savings Institution Bradstreet's.
