The Canadian Gazette, of London, England, on Dec. 11, says. "The experiment of shipping Canadian eggs to British markets was brought to a close on Tuesday by the arrival at Liverpool of the Lake Huron with 100 cases, i each containing 1,400 eggs. Since the McKinley tariff came into operation, no less than 1,000 cases, containing in all 1,400,000 eggs, have reached this country from Canada, and dealers who have handled the consignments say that were the McKinley law to be repealed -as it is not, of course, likely to be, at all events for some time to come-the Canadian egg merchants have so far already succeeded in meeting British requirements as to place the trade upon a sound and permanent footing. At the same time, we need hardly remind Canadian shippers that there is plenty of scope for the exercise of caution and enterprise.'
