### IRREGULAR VERBS.

Irregular Verbs are those which do not form their imperfect tense, and their perfect participle, by the addition of d or ed to the verb; as,

Imperfect. Perf. or Pass. Part. Present. I begin, I began, begun,

I know, I knew, known. The remaining tenses of this mood are, in general, similar to the correspondent tenses of the indicative mood. See the note at p. 30.
