1. If I be loved.
2. If thou be loved.
3. If he be loved.

Plural.

1. If we be loved.
2. If ye or you be loved.
3. If they be loved.

*Imperfect Tense.***Singular.**

1. If I were loved.
2. If thou wert loved.
3. If he were loved.

Plural.

1. If we were loved.
2. If ye or you were loved.
3. If they were loved.*

Infinitive Mood.*Present Tense.*

To be loved.

Perfect Tense.

To have been loved.

Participles.*Present.* Being loved.*Perfect or Passive.* Loved.*Compound Perfect.* Having been loved.**IRREGULAR VERBS.**

Irregular Verbs are those which do not form their imperfect tense, and their perfect participle, by the addition of *d* or *ed* to the verb; as,

Present.

I begin,

I know,

Imperfect.

I began,

I knew,

Perf. or Pass. Part.

begun,

known.
