

FINES—HOW TO BE SETTLED.

4. All fines, imposed if not settled at the time, shall be charged by the Financial Secretary to the member from whom due, and shall stand against him as regular dues, and must be liquidated to entitle him to all the privileges of this Association.

DECORUM.

5. Should any member of this Association make observations, foreign to the subject under debate, or inconsistent with the regulations, they shall be called to order; and should they interrupt another while speaking, and refuse to come to order when called by the President, shall be subject to a fine of ten cents.

6. Should any member or officer, come to this Association under the influence of Liquor, or acting in a disorderly manner, or using profane language, shall be subject to a fine of fifty cents cash down if proven, and if not paid within one month, shall be subject to expulsion.

CONDUCT.

7. Any member convicted of a crime by any judicial tribunal, may be suspended or expelled, according to the nature of the offence, by a majority vote of the Association, without any formal charge, notice or trial.

FUNDS—HOW APPROPRIATED.

8. The funds of this Association shall be deposited in the Dominion Savings' Bank by the Treasurer, and the President or one of the Vice Presidents, and in the name of this Association, and the Treasurer shall not keep in his possession any sum exceeding Five Dollars, and can only be drawn on order of the President countersigned by the Secretary.

9. No money shall be appropriated or used for any other purpose, than defraying the necessary expenses of this Association unless two thirds of all the members vote to do so.

COMMITTEES.

10. All Committees shall consist of not more than five members unless otherwise ordered.

STANDING COMMITTEES.

11. The President shall appoint the following Standing Committees on assuming his office, viz. :—

Committee on Finance.

Committee on Sick and Distressed.

Committee on Political Action.
