A SCORE OF FAMILIES HOMELESS. The Life Lost Was That of a Child Whose Mother Fell While Rushing for Safety. Pittsburg, Pa., April 29 .- Fire at the orner of Carson and 17th-streets, Southside, to-day, cost one life, a property loss stimated at \$225,000, consumed over a

dozen buildings and rendered a score of families homeless. The flames were discovered in the basement of the 4-storey department store of George E. Lorsch & Brother, and in a very short time the entire building was burning furiously.
