

## OUTSIDERS BUY UP CANADIAN CATTLE

The volume of business in export cattle this week was small, the total being 344 cattle, against 579 a year ago. This is a very significant item from the Chicago Drivers' Journal of Aug. 6. Everyone knows that at the present time, on account of the strike the packers are unable to send over to British ports any quantity of cattle. This is the plain statement that they forwarded 1235 fewer live cattle. It was not scarcity of cattle on the Chicago market that brought about the decreased number for each day last week the market had many holdovers. The steamships leaving the Atlantic ports carried a full cargo of live cattle; agents at Montreal report having sold space for London and Liverpool at an advance of 2s. 6d. per head. The large exporters of live cattle in the United States do not run around the country picking up cattle, they buy them openly on the markets at Chicago, Kansas City and St. Louis. They adopt different tactics when they operate in Ontario. They call upon some of the largest live stock dealers in our best feeding sections and make large purchases of suitable exporters at an enhanced price and ship them thru to London or Liverpool.

There were 3200 less cattle on the Toronto markets in the past two weeks than a year ago, but the farmers have not considerably more than a year ago. A year ago prices for live cattle on the British markets were within a fraction of present cable prices and Toronto exporters paid fully up to present prices without complaint. Refrigerator beef is now selling 12c. higher per lb. in Liverpool than a year ago, the quantity is very limited, and the inference is that the butchers will naturally look for supplies from the fresh-killed export cattle. Buyers for large Chicago exporters have been purchasing a considerable number of live cattle in Ontario; they have paid higher prices than were obtained on the Toronto markets. The query is, Have the Canadian exporters been caught napping; have too many of them gone out west to handle the range cattle, or have the generally astute Chicago exporters taken upon them a monetary risk in buying our exporters at a higher figure? Some say they are trying to further depress prices for the best cattle on their own markets by milking up their cattle space on ships bound for Ontario cattle. In either event, higher prices have in certain instances been paid at Ontario outside points than have been paid on the Toronto markets.

## ARE U. S. WHEAT PRICES LOCAL?

Wheat futures at Chicago have mounted up again the past few days, and all of the futures are now above the dollar mark. Much of the twenty cents a bushel advance since about a month ago is due to doubtless to crop injury, but the fact that the English markets fail to respond to the advance in price is a matter that discredits upon the legitimacy of the total rise. It will be remembered early in the year that a like advance was brought about in the United States speculative centres, only to be followed by a fall in price in proportion to the original advance. At this time the European grain markets refused to follow the lead of Chicago. This did not prevent the importing countries from securing supplies, and as a matter of fact the receipts from the large wheat-exporting countries otherwise than the United States were on a larger scale than the previous year. The attitude of the British grain markets seems to indicate that little concern is felt there over the ultimate supply. American farmers who are now financially well fixed can afford to take advantage of the 15 cents a bushel tariff and thus ignore the world's price, as dictated from Liverpool. Canadian farmers, by reason of the large surplus, are in a position to export abroad, will still have to be governed by competition from other countries. Whether the advance inaugurated at Chicago will be carried into our own crop depends very much on the outcome of the Argentine, Indian, Australian and Russian crops of the present year.

## PACKERS' STRIKE AND ITS EFFECTS ON PRICES.

The packers' strike still being continued at Chicago and other western live stock centres is capable of various consequences in its relation to the live stock interests of other communities. The first result witnessed by the curtailment of supplies by the packers was a sharp advance in the English markets for imported cattle. This was not of long duration, for the reason that many shippers had made up the deficiency by increasing their output. At present British prices are steady, and the markets there are not overburdened with supplies. What will happen when the strike either collapses or might well cause reflection. During the month of July there were marketed at Chicago alone 127,400 cattle, 196,500 hogs and 101,300 sheep less than during the same month last year. Part of the falling off may be attributed to several causes, but it is certain that much of the decrease was due directly to the strike. If this volume of live stock has been held back for want of proper facilities for handling, it is certain that they will later come on the market in addition to the ordinary deliveries. Canadian exporters will need to keep a watchful eye on the movement across the line, and avoid if possible being caught in the throes of the first outlet of supplies after the labor struggle has been ended.

## MORE INQUIRY FOR CANADIAN HOGS.

The demoralized live stock markets throughout the United States are affecting the Canadian market. The representatives of the big packers of Chicago in

Canada are not pushing sales, and the Canadian pork packers are receiving more enquiries for their products. The large packers of hogs in the corn belt of the United States have always disposed of a large quantity of pork product in Eastern Canada and Newfoundland. This is the time of year that the merchants of the maritime provinces make their purchases. They will find it to their advantage to use the Canadian product, as the contractors for the large railroad constructions will use more Canadian hog product. The large pork-packing establishments of Canada are in a position to supply the increasing demand of our own consumers. The price for live hogs has been increased at Montreal, followed by an advance in Ontario; the ruling price at Toronto is \$5.50 per 100 lbs. for "selects." The farmers will be both to part with their live hogs at a lower price than they are receiving. The higher price of grain makes the rate of the feed. Many sections of the province report that the crop of pigs this season is far less than normal, and this fact will have its effect upon the market. The live hog market in the United States is most unsteady at present. That a large number of hogs are held back by the feeders is admitted, and temporarily slump may take place and prices be depressed by Canadian prices.

## FED HOGS STRYCHNINE.

Kansas Farmer Tried This for Strychnine.

A farmer near Fort Scott, Kansas, poisoned a lot of fine hogs by giving them strychnine. He thought as they should, and, although there was no disease among them, he decided to try it. He proceeded to dose up some of them with strychnine. He gave it to them in a body and of course they got more than their share. The result was that 14 of them died, and died quick, too, and almost immediately. Some of these would not die, but they were not able to give strong medicine to animals who are animals, without serious results, but it must be given in proper quantities and in a way that can be described by a physician or veterinarian.

## Poultry Industry.

What may appear insignificant to many is, however, a source of large interest to the poultry industry in this country. In the great field of diversified husbandry, few farmers are more successful than those who devote their attention to the raising of poultry. There are many advantages associated with the industry. The business can be conducted by individuals and does not require the period of usefulness in a commercial career. It does not involve the strenuous life of dairy farming and yet its successful prosecution requires both intelligence and industry. The broad public demand for diversified farm products is of increasing importance to the poultry industry, as well as operators with boundless wealth who wish to "exploit" agricultural, animal and poultry husbandry. To conduct a poultry ranch as a commercial enterprise requires ten to twenty acres of land, divided into appropriate sections for the different breeds of fowls, and a suitable place to grow poultry. Quite large flocks can be kept on an acre of land with a few trees and ground to grow crops for the poultry. The large ratio of profits, which is achieved by the use of intelligent management, is a feature of the industry. The poultry business does not demand great physical strength, its successful exploitation requires the most delicate of touch. The universal demand for poultry and eggs is such that the annual value of the industry reaches the enormous figure of \$300,000,000, being larger than any single agricultural resource, except dairying.

Like all business enterprises when inaugurated on a commercial scale, there have been many failures. ## Plaster and Lime on Soil.
