HAS A CLAIM OF \$20,000,000.

New York, June 15.—Seeking to establish his claim to a \$20,000,000 estate bequeathed for three generations by the late John D. Rockefeller, the government in 1700, which included a half mile wide strip of land along a half mile wide thru the heart of the City of Quebec, and eight acres adjacent to the City of Montreal, Mrs. Caroline Lambert Campbell, an American, the wife of John D.
