UNUSUAL LEGAL DISPUTE

Somerville Paper Box Company De-
fendants in Case Involving
Exchange Rate.

A legal dispute, said to be without
precedent in Canada, and the disposi-
tion of which will be watched by Cana-
dians with unusual interest, has arisen
through the issuance of a writ against
the Somerville Paper Box Company
Limited, of this city, by the American
Chicle Company of New York, for the
sum of \$50,000.
It seems that in 1910 the business and

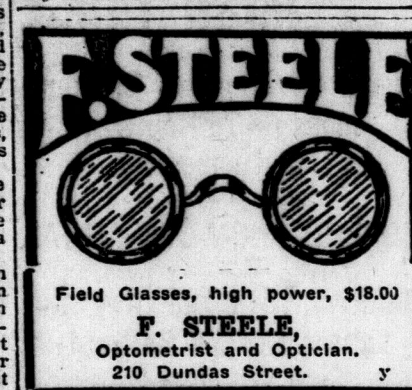
plant of Somerville Paper Box Company
was bought from the Sen-Sen Chicle
Company, which latter firm was later
absorbed by the American Chicle Com-
pany. The sale arrangements involved
a transaction whereby the Somerville
Company assumed a mortgage of \$50-
000, payable in legal money of Canada,
or in gold if demanded by the mort-
gagee. The present exchange condi-
tions have prompted the American
Chicle Company, who hold the mort-
gage, to demand payment in gold.
Under an order-in-council passed by
the Dominion Government in 1917, the
banking institutions are allowed to pay
their liabilities in other than gold, but
no provision was made for private in-
dividuals or corporations. Thus it will
be seen that a concern while willing
and ready to meet such an obligation in legal
money of the country, would be unable
to fulfill the contract because gold is
unobtainable.
The American Chicle Company have
agreed to accept the amount of the
mortgage payable in American funds,
which would mean that the local firm
would have to pay practically \$57,000
in Canada money at the present rate of
exchange. This they deem contrary to
the original agreement, and accordingly
are contesting the American Chicle
Company's demand.

LONDON GOING TO THE DOGS FOR TAXES

"London is going to the dogs," City
Treasurer James Bell stated Monday,
"for a very large portion of its taxes."
He backed up his statement by pro-
viding that the city has surpassed its
record for revenue from this source,
and is still hopeful of adding a good
many more dollars to the total. The
amount of money paid over to the city
to date in order that four-footed citi-
zens of the canine variety may be
permitted to exist within its precincts,
is \$1,250. This is \$15 more than was
collected all last year.
"One hundred and fifty dollars more
is going to be collected before December
31, either by this office or the police
court," the treasurer declared with a
"dogged" look.
If he succeeds in his purpose, London
may stand first in the list of Canadian
cities noted for the efficient manner in
which they collect their dog taxes. Sta-
tistics supplied from an independent
source show that only one or two other
municipalities in the Dominion collect
the same proportion of taxes as London

does at the present time. This year's
collection may place it in a class by it-
self.
