NOTE AND COMMENT

Don't think all the newspapers across the line back up Jim Sullivan in his tirade against the British Olympic methods, the most of them are pleased and many yellow. The Philadelphia Record in a review of the stadium games among other things said:

Carpenter's victory in the 400-metre run was as unexpected, although not unpopular, on this side as it was in England, and while the stories sent over make his disqualification seem unjust it is very possible that it was well-deserved. Certainly with three Americans against one Britisher it may be depended upon that Lieutenant Halswelle got none the best of it.

The unfortunate feature of the whole affair, continues the Record, is the bad blood stirred up over alleged unfair treatment accorded the Americans by the English Olympic officials. However, the hot words spoken under the sting of defeat should not be taken too seriously, and it should also be remembered that the two nations fighting for first honors were made up largely of the same blood and that both are very fond of winning. There was a lack of diplomacy on the part of the American Olympic Commissioner, James E. Sullivan, that was truly surprising, considering the amount of experience he has had, and the fact that he is responsible not only for a great portion of the unfavorable comment published in this country, but for the facts behind these reports as well. Mr. Sullivan went to Europe far in advance of the American team, presumably to get in touch with the details of the situation on the other side, but he seems to have made very poor use of his time. His arrangements for the accommodation of the team in London were so unsatisfactory that Trainer Murphy would not put up with them, and soon took his athletes to Brighton to train.

The frequent wrangles that have occurred during the progress of the games prove that the American side to go over the rules regulating the different events with the proper officials before the contests started. That is something he should have been selected for by coming to a full understanding he could not only have materially assisted the members of his team, but also avoided many of the unpleasant occurrences that have marred the meet. Mr. Sullivan is known to have been ambitious to act as an official in the games, and the fact that the English Olympic committee refused to grant his desire seemed to have put him in considerably. This bit of friction, however, Mr. Sullivan's arrogant manners, coupled with his name, appear to have rubbed the English committee the wrong way, and the American athletes were made to suffer for it.

As Dutchy Gibbons will probably make his second appearance this fall in the city boxing championship, why does not Bill Adams, the Thistle's goalkeeper, who seems anxious to have a bout with the versatile Little York half back, get in the list and avoid all this fight play on the side lines? As Adams retired last night involuntarily it is possible that the McMahon men will take the Thistle's goal, where he would be as useful as in other positions of the field.
