

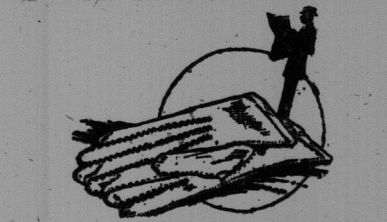
## SPORT NEWS GLEANED FROM WORLD'S CENTRES

Cleveland, Oct. 10.—Chewing tobacco while playing football cost the life of Chester Mares, 25, a Cleveland semi-pro player, who died of strangulation while being taken to a hospital at Painesville.

Mares, playing fullback at Willoughby, east of here, had just thrown a forward pass when he was knocked from his feet. In falling, a wad of tobacco became lodged in his throat. Efforts of physicians at the field to prevent death failed.

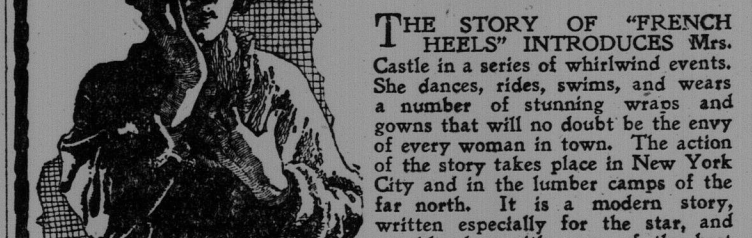
